STEM STRATEGIST (Accelerated STEM Grant-5th Round)

Purpose: The STEM Strategist is responsible for providing ongoing STEM instructional support in the elementary, middle school and high school through leadership in lesson planning, co-teaching, and facilitating STEM integration across grade levels and subject areas.

Staff Responsibility: The STEM strategist will work in cooperation with the teachers under the direct supervision of the superintendent, principals and ECSC STEM coach.

Description of Duties:

1. Organize a monthly STEM calendar at both buildings. The calendar will include a title of the STEM activity, duration, and grade level.
2. Be a liaison with the Community Advisory Board and the STEM coach. Use the Advisory Board for input and suggestions to assure STEM compliance with the grant. (Accelerated STEM grant-Round 5)
3. Collect data from Stem activities in the corporation, creating a history of activities to share with administrators and Community Advisory Board and used as historical reference.
4. Clarify and assist with development of STEM rubrics that are measurable and assess student knowledge.
5. Assist teachers with STEM initiatives, lessons and delivery.
6. Clarify and assist with development of STEM rubrics that are measurable and assess student knowledge.
7. Assist the STEM coach with overseeing the after school programs, assisting with program development, collecting attendance and follow up.
8. Communicate with Equitable Solutions in STEM certification Goals for the school corporation.
9. Communicate and meet as necessary with building principals and the superintendent to update the timeline of the plan of action. (Accelerated STEM grant-Round 5)
10. Coordinate with ECSC STEM coordinator for after school STEM education and sharing for teachers. (Teach 2 Teach)
